The 15th Frontiers in Low Temperature Plasma Diagnostics (FLTPD XV) workshop is the continuation of a very successful series that started in 1995 in Les Houches (France) and became an important forum for researchers dealing with low-temperature plasma diagnostics. Recent FLTPD events were held in Bad Honnef, Germany (2019) and in Levico Terme, Italy (2022).

According to the FLTPD "under one roof" tradition, the workshop will be held at Liblice Castle, approx. 40 km from the center of Prague and 60 km from Prague Airport (PRG). Castle Liblice is one of the most beautiful and well-preserved representatives of High Baroque Bohemian architecture. In addition to the castle with a large French formal garden designed by the Italian architect Giovanni Battista Alliprandi, the complex is complemented by two wings serving as an extension of the castle's accommodation capacity.

The program will traditionally consist of expert presentations by invited speakers, presentations by selected topical speakers and poster presentations. All FLTPD 2024 lectures will be held in the Main Conference Hall (capacity of 100 seats), while the poster section and sponsor booths will be located in the Marble Hall.

Abstract submission

Participation in the workshop is limited by the castle's accommodation capacity. All participants are therefore expected to present a contribution, either an oral presentation or a poster. We ask all those interested in participating in the workshop to submit an abstract (single A4 page) in English via the FLTPD 2024 website. Please follow the instructions in the abstract templates (Word/Latex) carefully, no editing/formatting will be provided. All abstracts must be uploaded in PDF format and by using the abstract submission form, which will be activated on Monday, 27th November 2023. The International Scientific Committee will review all submissions and select best contributions for oral presentations (25-min topical lectures) from the accepted abstracts.

Registration

Registration of participants will be possible only after the contribution has been accepted (either for oral or poster presentation). Each submitting author will receive by e-mail the decision of the ISC and (in case of acceptance) a unique registration link allowing to complete the registration by paying the registration fee (bank transfer only). Please note that due to limited accommodation capacity at the FLTPD 2024 venue, participant registrations will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Therefore, we strongly recommend that you register and pay the fee as soon as possible after your contribution is accepted!
